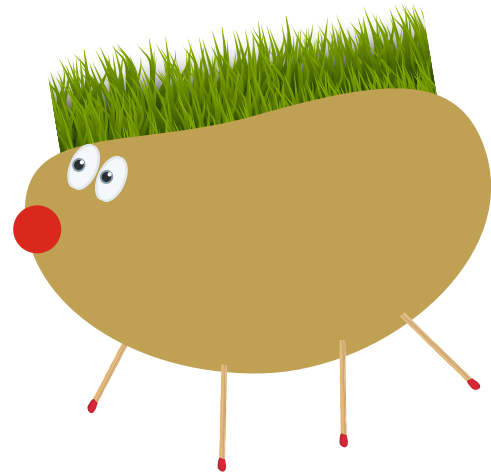


Make a cress hedgehog

A humble spud can be turned into a hedgehog with cress seeds

What you will need

- Potato
- Teaspoon
- Four used matchsticks
- Cotton wool
- Cress seeds



What to do

1. Pick a potato that fills the palm of your hand and scoop out a hollow in the middle at the top where you think the hedgehog prickles should be.
2. Stick the matchsticks in the bottom of the potato to make legs.
3. Fill the scooped out bit with cotton wool and dampen it with water.
4. Sprinkle liberally with cress or mustard seeds.
5. Place the hedgehog in a warm, light place and water daily.
6. In a week, you should have a cress crop to harvest.
