

Growing in a CD case

See how seeds grow by planting in a CD case

What you will need

- A clear CD case
- Compost
- Seeds
- Sticky tape



What to do

1. Fill half the case with compost.
2. Add your seed to the compost.
3. Seal the bottom and sides of the CD case with tape so water doesn't leak out.
4. Leave a gap at the top of the case so you can water your seed.
5. Place the CD case in a warm place and watch nature do the rest.
6. When the plant has outgrown the case, transplant it to a pot or the garden.

Learning opportunities

This experiment is a visual way of understanding how seeds grow and the role of soil, water and sunlight. Growth can be measured and recorded each day.
