

Making grass hands

What you will need

- Container to plant in (pie plates work well)
- Potting soil
- Grass seed
- Writing utensil (pen, pencil, marker)
- Scissors (preferable safety scissors)
- Construction (sugar) paper or card stock
- Water



What to do

1. Using your writing utensil, trace your hand on a piece of construction paper.
2. Use the scissors to cut out the image you just traced of your hand.
3. Fill your container nearly to the top with potting soil. You will want to leave at least an inch of space.
4. Immerse your paper hand print in the water.
5. Remove your paper hand print from the water quickly and lay it out on a flat surface.
6. Sprinkle grass seed over the paper hand print until it is covered.
7. Lay the seed-covered hand print on top of the soil in the container and cover it with about a quarter inch of soil.
8. Make sure that the pot receives sunlight and water as directed on the seed packet your seeds came from.
9. In a few days you should have a grassy hand print!
